Starting with the Limpopo Province, a **WESTERN MARSH HARRIER** has been reported at the intersection of the main road between Shingwedzi and Pafuri and the road leading off to the Punda Maria gate in the Kruger National Park whilst there seems to have been a little influx of **GREEN SANDPIPERS** with one reported below the bridge over the Crocodile River on the road west of and linking the R511 with Koedoeskop and another from the Polokwane Game Reserve. A third individual has also been reported from the Sabi Sand Game Reserve in Mpumalanga.
